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Dear Joe:

All of the material you ordered went out priority mail on Apr 26 and should have arrived by now. Here is a copy of your order form with all items checked off that were sent. This includes 82 sou sheets (NLP) and 12 Apollo covers. Total was \$44.15 and I show a balance due to you of \$15.85. However, I forgot to list the two space spectacular packages (15 covers in each) that I advertised in SC at \$7.50 each. With this letter is another package of 15. Let's make the charge \$5.00 each pack and that will take care of the \$15.85 credit. Hope this is okay. It works out to about 33¢ per cover.

I have a lot of cacheted unmanned covers (CC and KSC) of the early 1970s. If you are interested I could send 1 or more of each for 40¢ each. Let me know.

The Intergalactic Space Command cover and related material will go to you in about 10 days. I think you'll get a smile out of it.

You asked about different of sou sheets SE-5 and SE-1. Since you ordered both you will see that there is a difference in design and heading on the sheets. But you are right...they sure to look alike. I had to take a second look to see the difference.

About the Apollo 9 sou sheet. This sheet has the top row illustrating the command module and the bottom row the landing craft. Only 1 sheet but that is not clear in the old NLP catalog. Thanks for pointing that out and it will be changed in the new catalog.

Now a question or two from me. Your letterhead has a design of Paper Clip Scientists. I have written to about 40 of those still alive and have heard from about half. And some included a letter about what work they did at NASA. Do you have any printed material that could be copied about Project Paper Clip? Do you know af any books that would be available on the project?

The other question...do you have an autographed cover by Werner von Braun that is for sale (no autopen). If so, let me know how much and I will think about adding it to the collection of the others in the project.
