
APOLLO 11 FIRST MOON LANDING IN 1969

On July 20, 1969, Neil Armstrong communicated to Mission Control in Houston, "Houston, Tranquility Base here. The Eagle has landed." And with those famous words, the United States had put the first men on the Moon.

Our original SCCS Apollo 11 covers were issued in a set of three different cachets, one for launch date (July 16, 1969), Moon Landing date (July 20, 1969), and Splashdown date (July 24, 1969). This special dealer-estate price we have on these SCCS covers is about wholesale and also about a half of the normal retail price. We price these on this offering only at \$4.00 for the July 16, 1969 cover; \$4.50 for the July 20, 1969 cover; and \$3.50 for the July 24, 1969 cover. Remember, each of these covers has the Apollo 8 commemorative stamp, the Houston post office machine cancel, a single of the special NASA Local Post Commemorative, and the NASA Local Post pictorial hand cancel. Even if you have these covers, at this price it would be an ideal opportunity to secure another set for trading, or maybe as a gift.

APOLLO 11 FIFTH ANNIVERSARY

A special Apollo 11 Fifth Anniversary machine pictorial cancel was made available by the U. S. Postal Service and used at both Houston and Cape Canaveral. These retail for \$2.50 each now but this estate sale price is only \$1.25 each. Both of these covers have a matching cachet in black ink.

FIRST DAY OF USE OF THE FIFTH ANNIVERSARY SLOGAN CANCEL...July 20, 1974 was the first day of use of this slogan cancel and the last day of use was August 20, 1974. We have a different type of cachet for these two covers and either the July 20 or August 20, 1974 cover is priced at only \$1.25 each. The regular retail is about twice that amount. Both this first day of use and last day of use cover is cancelled at Houston.

SCCS MAILERS PERMIT HAND CANCEL...This was the original style of Mailer's Permit Postmark hand cancel authorized for the Space City Cover Society (holder of MPP permit #1 in Houston). A set of three covers was cancelled for the fifth anniversary of Apollo 11. One was on launch anniversary, one for Moon Lanidng anniversary, and one for Splashdown anniversary. This set of three covers, also from the dealer-estate, is priced at only \$3.25 per set.
