

SHUTTLE ORBITER COLUMBIA

The Space Shuttle Orbiter Columbia will be the first to fly into Earth orbit with that flight now scheduled the latter part of this year. There will be several important events happening at Cape Canaveral and Houston. And we will be servicing covers for them. But please remember...we will only be doing those events that collectors would call major. You will not be overburdened with event covers but by continuing your Space City Cover Society series, neither will you miss any of the important ones.

SPACE SHUTTLE MAIN ENGINES...There are three of these and testing has been done in Mississippi over the past year or so. Getting the engines perfected has been one reason for the delay in the Shuttle program, but these three main engines will be delivered to the Vehicle Assembly Building in July and then mated to the Columbia. They will arrive at different times and we will have a cover for each postmarked on the arrival date at the Canaveral area. Set of three for \$2.65

EXTERNAL TANK FOR COLUMBIA...This tank will be used on the Columbia to hold about 1,500,000 pounds of usable propellant. It will arrive at the Shuttle Complex in July. We will have one cover, postmarked on arrival date and priced at 90¢

SOLID ROCKET BOOSTER FOR COLUMBIA...Two solid rocket boosters (SRB) burn in parallel with the main propulsion system of the Orbiter to provide initial ascent thrust. These will be "stacked" for the first flight in July or thereabouts and we will have a cover for it. Price is 90¢
