I have a complaint about SCCS! I have not received any of my orders that I have placed with SCCS for sometime. I have also written several letters inquiring about my orders, but I have not received any reply. I would like to know what is happening!

I do enjoy collecting your material, but it seems that I'm going to give it up until this problem is resolved.

On July 6, 1980, I ordered the 2nd Shuttle Astronauts souvenir sheets of which I never received them.

On November 28, 1980, I ordered the Private Express Mail Booklet #4 of which I also never received.

On March 14, 1981, I wrote a second check for the 2nd Shuttle Astronauts souvenir sheets, thinking that the USPS lost my original order and check. Still, I have not received them.

On June 9, 1981, I ordered \$38.35 worth of the USPS Space Commemorative Stamp Covers and they have also yet to arrive.

As of now, one of the above orders was placed over a year ago. A second order is closely approaching being over a year old too. So, I would really appreciate a reply and the orders filled and shipped.

It should also be noted that the only check returned to me by my bank was issued for the Private Express Mail Booklet #4. None of the other checks that I have written to SCCS have cleared my bank and returned to me.
