SPACE SHUTTLE COVERS

This is a complete listing of all covers produced by the Space City Cover Society for the Space Shuttle Program up through the final Manned Free Flight of October 26, 1977. This list will be revised at intervals as new events are added. However, this list is for the "General" and "Approach and Landing Test" categories only. We have a separate listing for the "NASA Jet Star" test flights (flown at Edwards); "Gulfstream Jet" training flights (flown at Houston); and the "F-8 Test Flights" (flown at Edwards). Unless otherwise indicated, all of the covers on this list are machine cancel. Postmarks are in parenthesis: (E) = Edwards CA, (H) = Houston TX and (P) = Palmdale CA.

* This asterick means that the covers also contains a NASA Local Post and cancel.

APPROACH AND LANDING TESTS COVERS

The year-long tests that took up most of 1977 were made to verify the aerodynamic and flight control characteristics of the first Shuttle Orbiter (Enterprise) and took place at NASA's Dryden Flight Research Center, Edwards, Calif. These ALT Orbiter Test Flights were under the management of NASA's Johnson Space Center in Houston.

It all began back in 1975 with the Shuttle Ferry (Boeing 747) tests. In early 1976, the 747 went to the Boeing plant in Seattle to be modified so that it could carry the Orbiter 101 on its top-side. It returned to Edwards on January 14, 1977 and in February the Orbiter 101 was mated to it. From then on, it was one successful test after another, culminating in the five Manned Free Flights during August through October 1977. These were the flights when the Orbiter 101 was fired loose from the NASA 747 and the four ALT astronauts, in teams of two each, made the Orbiter landings at Edwards.

GENERAL SHUTTLE COVERS

Since most of the Shuttle activity so far has been connected with the ALT tests, we have made a category of other Shuttle covers labeled "GENERAL". We felt this would be helpful to the collector who wanted to mount a collection by category.
